

ORDINANCE NO. 653

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MONTEREY PENINSULA AIRPORT DISTRICT
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 529 FOR THE CONTROL OF SMOKING
AT THE MONTEREY PENINSULA AIRPORT

WHEREAS, state law now provides a uniform statewide standard to restrict and prohibit the smoking of tobacco products in enclosed places of employment, and

WHEREAS, such state law was enacted with the intent to eliminate the need for local governments to enact workplace smoking restrictions within their respective jurisdictions, and

WHEREAS, in view of present state law Ordinance No. 529 is no longer needed for the purpose of regulating smoking at the Monterey Peninsula Airport,

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MONTEREY PENINSULA AIRPORT DISTRICT DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 529, for the Control of Smoking at the Monterey Peninsula Airport, declaring the policy of the Monterey Peninsula Airport District to enforce the standards, rules and regulations set forth in the Smoking Pollution Control Ordinance of the County of Monterey, and exempting the application of smoking prohibitions to bars, is hereby repealed.
