

ORDINANCE NO. 232

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET OF THE MONTEREY PENINSULA AIRPORT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1974, AND THE SALARY BUDGET THEREIN AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MONTEREY PENINSULA AIRPORT DISTRICT DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That the estimates submitted to the said Board of Directors of the Monterey Peninsula Airport District on the 11th day of July, 1973, entitled "Monterey Peninsula Airport District Budget, County of Monterey, State of California, Fiscal Year 1974 having been amended by said Board and said estimates as amended are attached hereto and hereby referred to for further particulars, be, and said estimates as amended are hereby approved and adopted as the Budget of the said District for the Fiscal Year 1974.

SECTION II: That the revenues of said District for the Fiscal Year 1974 are hereby appropriated as set forth and segregated in said Amended Budget, and all annual salaries, compensations, allowances as set forth in said Amended Budget contained therein are hereby fixed and established as therein specified, and shall be payable in time, form and manner as prescribed by the Monterey Peninsula Airport District Act, approved March 22, 1941, and by the Ordinances of said District and Resolution of said Board of Directors.

SECTION III: That salaries, compensations and allowances as set forth in said Budget as amended for the Officers and Employees of said District for the Fiscal Year 1974, shall be in effect and payable as of the First Day of said Fiscal Year, to-wit, The First day of July 1973.

SECTION IV: That all funds mentioned in said Amended Budget for said Fiscal Year are hereby established and designated as in said Budget.

SECTION V: That surpluses in any fund set forth in said Amended Budget may be transferred by a formal action of the Board of Directors of said District from any such fund to any other fund as set forth in said Amended Budget from time to time as said Board may deem necessary, or convenient.

SECTION VI: That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances, insofar as they conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be urgent and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall

take effect and be in force forthwith from and after its final passage and approval. The following is a statement of such urgency: Said Ordinance is immediately required to maintain and carry on effective government in said District whereby to preserve the public peace, health and safety thereof.
