

ORDINANCE NO. 816

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE ADJUSTMENT
OF LANDING FEES AT THE MONTEREY PENINSULA AIRPORT

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 619 set the current landing fees and established the policy and procedures for collecting and adjusting landing fees for operation of aircraft at the Monterey Peninsula Airport; and

WHEREAS, landing fees contribute to the recovery of costs for operating, maintaining, and improving airport facilities, pursuant to the public airport's user pay philosophy; and

WHEREAS, landing fees were last adjusted effective January 1997;

NOW, therefore be it resolved that landing fees for operation of aircraft at the Monterey Peninsula Airport, shall be adjusted as follows:

1.0 GENERAL AVIATION AIRCRAFT. The landing fee shall be \$1.00 per thousand pounds of the certificated gross landing weight, rounded to the nearest dollar.

2.0 HELICOPTERS. The landing fee shall be \$6.00 per landing.

3.0 AIR CARRIERS. The landing fee shall be \$1.37 per thousand pounds of the certificated gross landing weight, rounded to the nearest dollar.

4.0 FREIGHT/CARGO CARRIER. For aircraft operated by freight/cargo air carriers, the fee shall continue to be specified in the applicable operating agreements.

5.0 ORDINANCE NO. 619. Except to the extent modified herein, all provisions of Ordinance No. 619 shall remain in effect. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the weight exemption contained in section 2.0 of Ordinance No. 619, the based vehicle exemptions contained in section 2.1 and 3.1 of Ordinance No. 619, and the general exemptions contained in section 5.0 of Ordinance No. 619 shall remain in effect.

6.0 The effective date of the adjustments stated herein shall be July 1, 2003.
