# D. REGULAR AGENDA - ACTION ITEMS

Discussion 1. Air Service Update

Executive Director La Pier updated the Committee on current and future air service additions and changes. Director Sabo requested that, when known, future air service additions be added for information to the published air service schedule. Executive Director La Pier indicated that information could be included.

Executive Director La Pier shared with the Committee a chart indicating the number of daily throughput of passengers at TSA checkpoints nationally for the period August 14 through 25, 2020. The information indicated that nationally 2020 passenger traffic was at or near 30% of the same period in 2019. Discussion occurred regarding the comparison numbers for MRY. MRY's traffic is consistent with or near the national average as presented. Director Sabo stated he thought this was a good metric to measure our passenger levels.
